

Kentucky Miniature Horse Breeders Club Youth Incentive Fund

KMHBIF nominated horses will receive money for AMHA youth points, (with the exception of showmanship points). Points can be acquired at any AMHA sanctioned show. For Kentucky AMHA sanctioned shows, the points are doubled.

Monies for the youth incentive will be provided by the KMHBC. There will be a specific amount set aside for the youth fund each year.

Points will be calculated like AMHA Honor Roll Points*. Show year will be January 1st thru December 31st. For 2012 only, points from 2011, 30 days prior to the World Show cutoff thru December 31st, 2011, will be included in the 2012 payout period. See AMHA rulebook WS-030-B. All approved shows held in Kentucky will earn double points. AMHA World Show does not earn points. There will be a cap of 30 youth points per horse per year and a maximum payout of \$25.00 per point.

Once a horse is nominated into the KMHBIF, any youth that wants to participate in this program will need to fill out a youth nomination form for each horse and send to the KMHBC, there will no additional charge for the youth nomination form. The youth nomination form for the youth/horse combination is due before December 1 of the year that the horse is being shown and is good for each year that this youth/horse combination is shown. If the youth starts showing another horse then a nomination form should be submitted for that youth/horse combination.

For the youth to earn monies, the nominated horse must be owned by the youth or their mother, father, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, legal guardian, grandparent, step parents, Step siblings, step grandparents or family-owned corporation, ranch or farm.

Owners of nominated horses must be a current member of Kentucky Miniature Horse Breeders Club and The American Miniature Horse Association.

Youth must be a member of AMHyA and the youth must be a member of the KMHBC.
A copy of the AMHyA youth membership card must be on file with the KMHBC.

All nominated foals must be DNA'd. All foals of sires and dams born after January 1, 1996 must be parent qualified. A copy of the foal's DNA must be on file with KMHBC prior to all payouts. Foal may be DNA'd after nomination.

Points shall be awarded on the following basis to qualifying horses entered and exhibited in AMHA sanctioned shows.
